

GENERAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM OPEN ENROLLMENT

June 13 through June 20, 2011

Applications for General Assistance will only be considered if received within normal business hours during this open enrollment period.

- Applications received after 6 p.m. on June 9th will be date stamped and considered as received on June 13th.
- Applications received after 6 p.m. on June 20th will be denied.

The General Assistance (GA) program provides limited financial assistance to disabled adults without dependent children. To become eligible for GA, applicants will be required to provide evidence of a physical and/or mental health impairment that prevents them from working at all in any occupation. Additional verifications may also be requested to ensure all eligibility requirements are met.

Individuals who are receiving Unemployment benefits, Social Security Disability (SSI/SSDI) benefits, or individuals who have been denied SSA disability benefits at the hearing level are not eligible for GA unless they can verify an unrelated condition has developed.
